

Software Developer (f/m/d), 6 months

Full-time position (E13 TV-L, 100%) at the Institute of Geography and Geoecology of KIT, start immediately. Mobile working can be arranged.

As a "Research University in the Helmholtz Society", KIT creates knowledge for society and the environment. At the Institute of Geography and Geoecology, we investigate interactions between society, soils, water, vegetation and climate. One of the focal points is vegetation ecology, which is also the context of this position.

The project involves the development of a web application for

1. converting files of different formats into the VegX exchange format for vegetation data (www.ifgg.kit.edu/vegetation/vegx/) and
2. the conversion of VegX documents into files for import into existing databases.
3. user-friendly documentation.

The call addresses software developers as well as e.g. ecologists with programming experience (R / Shiny would be advantageous) and good knowledge of XML. The willingness to regularly exchange information about the implementation is a prerequisite.

We would also be particularly pleased to receive applications from women. In the case of equal suitability, severely disabled persons will be given preferential consideration.
